

A Visit to a Petting Farm

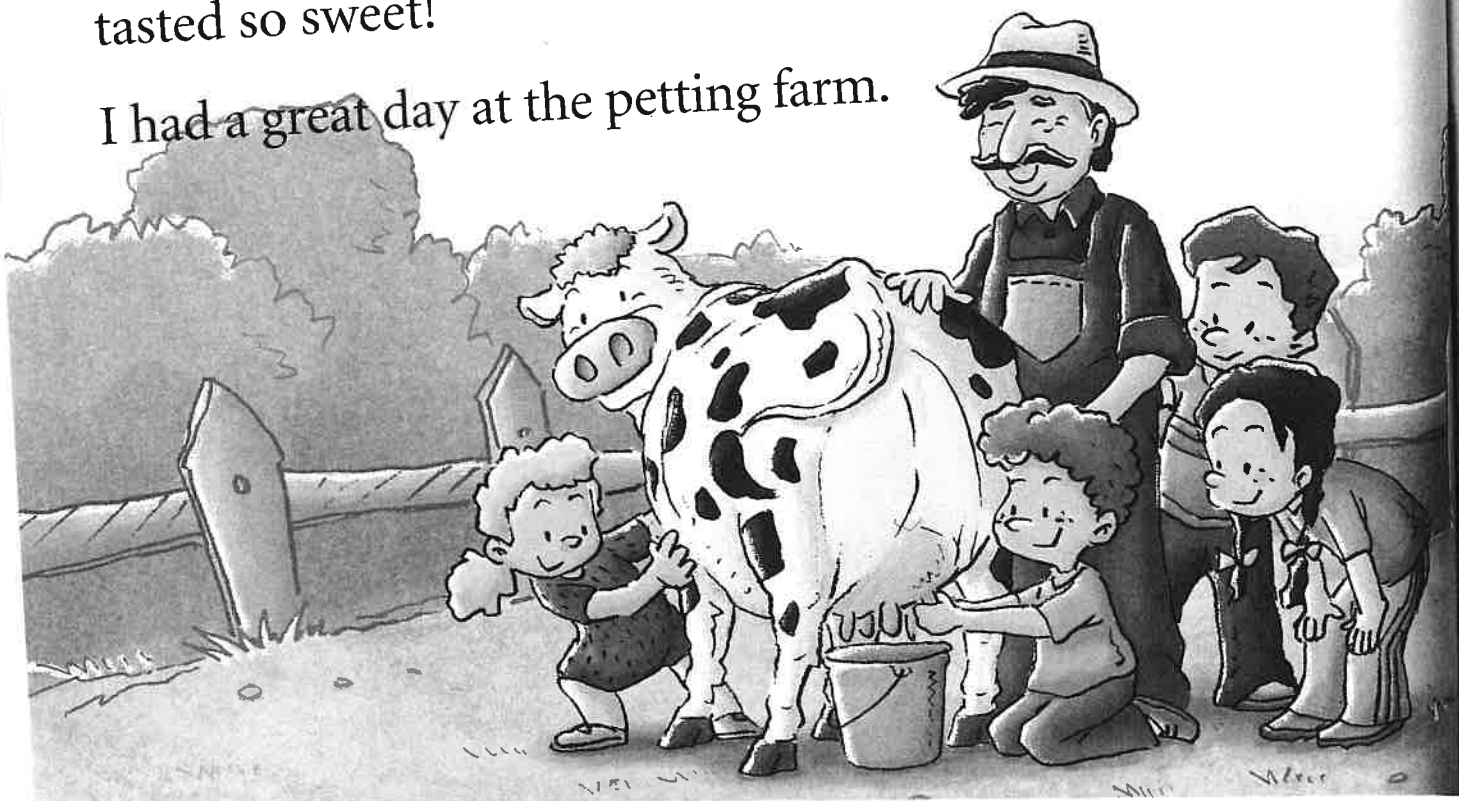
Today my class visited a petting farm in the countryside. We saw many animals at the farm. There were goats and pigs. They were fun to watch.

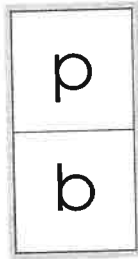
Beginning Consonants

The **beginning consonant** of a word is the beginning sound that is not a vowel (a, e, i, o, u).

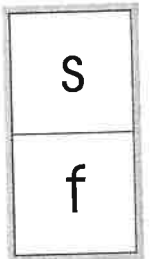
Examples: fun ride day
